The Center for Hellenic Studies in Greece (CHS GR) is a cultural and educational research center based in Nafplion, Greece. An annex of Harvard University's Center for Hellenic Studies in Washington, DC, CHS GR utilizes the knowledge and expertise of Harvard's faculty and research centers and is a key part of Harvard's continuing effort to expand its international presence. The Center is an important nexus for the network of research centers operated by Harvard in Europe, and it is accessible, and free of charge, to the general public.

Within the academic year **2010/11 and 2011/12** the Center is planning to offer a few positions (depending on chosen dates and organizations' availability) for a period of 1 to 3 months to students from Wroclaw University, accepted in the LLP Erasmus Student Mobility for Placement, either in CHS and/or in one of our partner institution.
