1. Polish and German Society compared in the European context
Seminar, 30 h, Wednesday 11:15-12:45 h, Willy Brandt Centre, Room 43

The seminar introduces the comparison of societies in Europe, focusing particularly on two largest countries in the centre of Europe: Poland and Germany. The lecture starts with the logic of international comparison and then takes a closer look at various sectors of society in turn, such as social inequality, economy, leisure activities, education, migration, etc. For each societal sector, we conceptualize the comparison and look at empirical findings to get a better knowledge where in the European range of variety Poland and Germany can be found. The seminar builds on texts read by all and short presentations of additional information.

2. Social Stratification in Europe
Seminar, 30 h, Wednesday 17:15-18:45 h, Willy Brandt Centre, Room 43

Life chances are fundamentally different in Europe. This applies to countries as well as to people within countries. The seminar starts with the conceptualizations of social strata (class, caste, party, milieu) and proceeds to different aspects of social inequality. Throughout the seminar we will combine conceptual issues, empirical findings, and a debate on possible consequences. The seminar builds on texts read by all and short presentations of additional information.
