- *Obligatory courses for the 1st year students in Italics.*
- **Obligatory exams for MA students of the 1<sup>st</sup> year:**
  1. *Introduction to International Migration and Immigrant* – **Dr hab. Patrycja Matusz-Protasiewicz** - obligatory exam
  2. *International Economic Transactions* – **Dr hab. Marek Wróblewski** - obligatory exam
  3. *Polish language* – **School of Polish Language and Culture** – obligatory exam
- In the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester MA students of the 1<sup>st</sup> year have 23 ECTS from obligatory courses and need to collect 7 ECTS of additional courses and workshops. Every additional course has 4 ECTS, every additional workshop 2 ECTS.

#### **Important information for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year Erasmus Mundus Global Studies students:**

- Meetings within Individual Diploma Seminars are not listed in the schedule, and are held upon individual agreement with the supervisor.
- Students receive 10 ECTS for the MA Seminar and 10 for Master Thesis and Defense. Students need to collect additional 10 ECTS of optional courses and workshops. Every additional course has 4 ECTS, every additional workshop 2 ECTS.
