Additional information:

1. Foreign students are required to complete a 60-hour course of Polish which ends with an examination at the A1 level. Students earn 5 credits when they have passed the examination. Polish students take up an elective course instead.
2. All students are required to complete a 180-hour course of a foreign language other than English and Polish. A2 is the minimum requirement as to the level at which the course must be completed. The course starts in semester 3. Students earn 12 credits when they have passed the final examination. Students must earn credits in semester 6 at the latest.
